- UP-English has been divided into three 4-week half-courses (UP-English A, B, and C). However, it is possible to complete the program in two sessions.
- Each half course is a complete and independent unit.
- Students may take the three half courses in any order.
- To satisfy their university English admission requirement, students must meet the requirements of the courses
- If students do not meet the requirements of the courses, they will receive an Incomplete (not Fail), and may take another UP-English course until they meet all the requirements.
- UP-English C will be offered every whenever a UP-A session is offered.

In submitting this application I understand and agree that:

1. Registration constitutes an agreement that ILI will provide a program of instruction, that I will follow the program of instruction for the period covered by my paid tuition, and that I will abide by the policies as stated in the ILI Student Handbook
2. Any request to change this agreement must be made in writing at least two weeks before any affected semester;
3. I qualify for a refund only after completing my first full semester (8 weeks) of full-time study at ILI including the original start date;
4. ILI does not refund the discounted portion of tuition pre-paid to an agent;
5. Any eligible refund is subject to a 30% administrative processing charge;
6. I will pay for a minimum of four weeks accommodation fees, at least four weeks in advance for every term I require host family accommodation. Students under the age of 19 must pay all host family accommodation fees for the entire duration of their studies at the time of registration.
7. Health and accident insurance is mandatory for all ILI students. I will maintain valid insurance during my entire study period at ILI;
8. If I choose not to purchase health and accident insurance through ILI, I will provide the Registrar with a copy of my insurance policy before the start of my study period;
9. Students under the age of 19 are subject to the terms of the ILI Agreement Governing Minor Students; and
10. ILI will disclose student information to third parties where the third party is a parent, a legally responsible guardian, a Canadian host parent, a government or corporate sponsor that has paid for the student's instruction, or where the student initiates the request and gives ILI his or her written unconditional and irrevocable consent to do so, or where ILI is required to provide personal information of the student by Canadian Law or Court Order.

ILI will issue a formal letter of acceptance when your application is complete and the application fee has been paid. A complete application always includes payment of all appropriate fees and the signature of the applicant or an auto-rized agent /representative.

2. ILI will email your Letter of Acceptance only after the registrar receives your signed Student Application Form and the payment of your registration fee (non refundable). If you would like to receive the letter by courier, a courier fee of \$80CDN is required in advance.

4. When you receive your authorization to enter Canada from the Embassy, please

A. ensure your fees are paid in full

B. make your travel arrangements

C. confirm and submit your arrival information to ILI at least **three** weeks before you arrive. Include:

i. Arriving flight number and carrier at Halifax International Airport

ii. Date and arrival time at Halifax International Airport.

Please note host family placement and airport pickup cannot be arranged until fees are paid in full.
